2. You never date.

The main surefire sign is this – only talking about sex. The relationship being purely sexual. If he doesn't show ANY signs that he wants to see you outside of a sexual context, it is a huge red flag.

What you also need to know is that all guys want sex. And that is a good thing. The bad thing is that, a lot of times the guy who just wants to have sex with one girl, is dying to be in a relationship. Just not with that girl. And just because he's coming back for sex, doesn't mean he's coming back for you. It's harsh, but it is reality.

What to do from here?
